Introduction

1. The Applicant, a staff member of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights ("OHCHR"), contests the decision not to grant him sufficient time for his relocation from Geneva to Suva and the subsequent withdrawal of the temporary appointment offer for a position of Human Rights Officer ("TJO 219180").

2. On 9 August 2024, the Respondent filed his reply.

3. On 30 August 2024, the Applicant filed a motion for production of evidence.

4. On 1 October 2024, the Applicant filed a motion for anonymity.

Consideration

5. To rule on the Applicant's motions for production of evidence and anonymity, the Tribunal considers it appropriate to instruct the Respondent to provide his response to them.
