Introduction

1. The Applicant, a staff member of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (“OHCHR”), contests his non-selection for the position of Humanitarian Affairs Officer/Reporting and Analysis (P-3 level), in the Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs in Kabul, advertised under Job Opening No. 225821.
2. On 19 September 2024, the Respondent filed his reply.
3. On 24 September 2024, the Applicant filed a motion for production of evidence.
4. On 1 October 2024, the Applicant filed a motion for confidentiality.

5. To rule on the Applicant’s motions for production of evidence and anonymity, the Tribunal considers it appropriate to first instruct the Respondent to provide his response to them.
