## **Introduction**

1. The Applicant is a Staff member at the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP). In her Application dated 26 November 2012, she is contesting the decision to downgrade her level without classification following a renumbering exercise at the Montreal duty station. She alleges that she was never informed officially from the United Nations Office at Nairobi (UNON)/UNEP upon accepting the offer at the G6 level that the Montreal duty station, her post would be subjected to downgrading.

2. For purposes of a fair and expeditious disposal of the case, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management hearing.

3. A case management hearing in this case will take place on 21 January 2013 at 1600 hours (Nairobi Time, UTC +3) in Conference Room 12.
