**ORDER ON APPLICANT'S MOTION TO
DISCONTINUE**

Introduction

1. The Applicant was recruited by the United Nations as a P-3 statistician at the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA).
2. On 28 March 2012, he filed an Application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal challenging the implied refusal by the United Nations Office of Internal Oversight Services (OIOS) to conclude an investigation implicating him in an alleged network of passport trafficking.
3. The Respondent submitted his Reply on 3 May 2012 contending that the Application was not receivable.
4. In Judgment No. UNDT/2013/132, dated 30 October 2013, this Tribunal held that the Application was receivable.
5. By Order No. 082 (NBI/2014), dated 23 April 2014, the Parties were informed of the Tribunal's decision to hold a hearing from 23 to 26 June 2014 in this matter.
6. On 16 June 2014, the Applicant filed a Motion to discontinue his case on the basis that the parties had amicably resolved the dispute.

In light of the Applicant's request for his case to be removed from the Tribunal's docket;

IT IS ACCORDINGLY ORDERED THAT:

7. The matter of *Lubbad v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*, registered as Case No. UNDT/NBI/2012/018, be struck off the Tribunal's docket.
