## ORDER ON THE APPLICANT'S APPLICATION FOR SUSPENSION OF ACTION

Introduction

1. The Applicant holds a permanent appointment with the United Nations. She is

currently the Chief of Mission Support at the United Nations Assistance Mission in

Iraq (UNAMI). She serves at the D1 level and is based in Baghdad.

2. On 19 January 2015, the Applicant filed the subject Application of this Order

seeking an injunction against the decision of the Under-Secretary-General of the

United Nations Department of Field Support, Ms Ammerah Haq, to terminate her

contract with UNAMI as of 20 January 2015.

3. The Applicant submits that her appointment with UNAMI was up for renewal

on 9 February 2015, and that the decision to terminate her appointment with the

Mission was not communicated to her. She came to know of the impugned decision

from the Administrative Assistant assigned to check her out of the Mission.

4. The Application for Suspension of Action has been served on the Respondent

for a response by noon, 20 January 2015.

**Deliberations and Directions** 

5. The Tribunal has considered the Applicant's submissions and takes the view

that allowing an oral hearing would facilitate the fair conduct of proceedings in this

matter.

6. While there is enough on the record at this stage to show that the impugned

decision is at least prima facie unlawful, a hearing of the Parties would clarify the

facts and submissions of both Parties and thereby facilitate the fair conduct of

proceedings in this matter.

7. The Tribunal is also of the view that the services of counsel will assist the Applicant and the Tribunal in the management and conduct of this case.

- 8. To this end, the Applicant is advised to seek legal counsel for the conduct of her case. Information on legal assistance is available at http://www.un.org/en/oaj/legalassist/howto.shtml.
- 9. The Tribunal therefore makes the following **ORDERS** 
  - The Application for Suspension of Action is GRANTED and the impugned decision is SUSPENDED up to 23 January 2015.
  - ii. The Parties are hereby **DIRECTED** to file their respective witness lists, if any, with a summary of the anticipated testimony by **0930hrs** (Nairobi time) on **21 January 2015**. Should the list include witnesses who will be testifying remotely, Parties are requested to provide the Registry with the relevant contact details.
  - iii. **NOTICE** is hereby issued that the matter of *Yasin v Secretary-General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2015/025) is set down for hearing at 1100hrs (Nairobi time) on 21 January in the UNDT Courtroom (CR-12).
  - iv. The Tribunal also **DIRECTS** the **IMMEDIATE** service of the present Order on the Office of Staff Legal Assistance to facilitate the process.
