ORDER ON THE PARTIES' JOINT MOTION TO ADJOURN PROCEEDINGS PENDING INFORMAL SETTLEMENT DISCUSSIONS

The Application and Procedural History

- 1. The Applicant is an Audio Visual Technician on a fixed term appointment at the G4 level in the Communications Section of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic (MINUSCA).
- 2. On 13 April 2015, the Applicant filed an Application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) in Nairobi challenging the Respondent's failure to take adequate measures to adequately ensure his safety, and decisions to treat his absence from the duty station as unauthorised and "the attendant decision not to return to him the salary" that was withheld.
- 3. The Respondent's Reply is due on 14 May 2015.
- 4. On 7 May 2015, the Parties filed the subject motion of the present decision for adjournment of proceedings pending the outcome of settlement discussions which are now at an advanced stage.

Deliberations and Order

- 5. The Tribunal commends the Parties for its proactive efforts in having this matter resolved without recourse to litigation.
- 6. The Tribunal therefore **GRANTS** the Parties' motion for adjournment of proceedings.
- 7. Pursuant to article 10.3 of the Statute of the Tribunal, and art. 19 of the Rules of Procedure, the matter of *Nya Nana v Secretary-General of the United Nations* (Case No. UNDT/NBI/2015/037) is hereby **SUSPENDED**.
