The Application and Procedural History

1. The Applicant is a Legal Officer at the United Nations Organisation Stabilisation Mission in the Democratic Republic of Congo (MONUSCO). He serves on a fixed-term appointment at the P-4 level in Kinshasa.
2. On 15 June 2015, the Applicant filed an Application for Suspension of Action seeking an injunction against the decision not to renew his appointment.
3. The Respondent filed his Reply to the Application on 16 June 2015. The Respondent informs the Tribunal that the impugned decision has been suspended pending management evaluation, thus making the Application before the Tribunal moot.

ORDER

4. The Respondent is correct in that there is no longer a dispute to be adjudicated upon by the Tribunal, as the relief sought by the Applicant has been granted by the Secretary-General.
5. The Application for Suspension of Action is therefore **DISMISSED**.
