ORDER ON AN APPLICATION FOR SUSPENSION OF ACTION

Introduction

1. On 18 June 2015, the Applicant, an FS-5 Administrative Assistant in the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of Congo (MONUSCO), filed an Application with the Dispute Tribunal seeking the suspension of the implementation of the decision not to renew her appointment.

2. On 22 June 2015, the Respondent filed his Reply to the Application advising the Tribunal that the "MONUSCO administration has suspended the contested decision pending management evaluation" and that "the Application is therefore moot because the Applicant has been provided with the relief she sought".

3. The Respondent annexed to his Reply a copy of an email from a MONUSCO Human Resources Officer informing the Applicant that MONUSCO had agreed not to proceed with her separation until the Management Evaluation Unit pronounces itself on her request for management review.

4. On 23 June 2015, the Applicant submitted a response to the Reply in which she submitted that since her requested relief had been granted, the case should be dismissed and requested no further relief.

ORDER

5. The Tribunal agrees that there is no longer a dispute to be adjudicated upon as the relief sought by the Applicant has been granted by the MONUSCO Administration.

6. The Application for Suspension of Action is accordingly **DISMISSED.**
