Introduction

1. The Applicant holds a fixed term appointment, at the GS5 level. He serves as an Information Technology Assistant at the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of Congo (MONUSCO), and is based in Kinshasa.
2. On 4 September 2015, the Applicant filed an application on the merits challenging the Respondent's decision to place him on administrative leave without pay. Attached to the substantive application was a motion for an injunction pursuant to art. 14 of the Rules of Procedure.
3. The Respondent was given 30 days to file his Reply to the Application.
4. On 8 September 2015, the Applicant filed the subject motion of the present Order moving the Court for leave to discontinue proceedings.

5. The Tribunal hereby **RECORDS** the contents of the Applicant's Notice and **ORDERS** that the matter of *Alimasi v Secretary General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2015/094) be struck off the Court's docket.
