Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former staff member of the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS). On 18 November 2015, he filed an Application against UNOPS.

2. On 11 December 2015 the Respondent filed his Reply.

3. Having considered the Application and the Reply, and having noted that the Respondent has raised issues of receivability:

IT IS ORDERED THAT

4. The Applicant is to file a succinct response, not exceeding three pages, indicating whether he accepts or, alternatively, challenges the Respondent's contention that the claim is not receivable because the Applicant did not request management evaluation and that, in any event, his claim is time barred because he was notified of the contested decision on 5 March 2015 and did not file his Application until 18 November 2015.

5. The Parties are to confirm their agreement that this claim may be decided on the basis of the documents and if either party disagrees, they are to state their reasons in a concise submission not exceeding one page identifying the issues in respect of which oral evidence will be helpful to reach a just determination.

The Parties are directed to file their submissions by Monday, 22 August
2016.
