Introduction

1. On 9 August 2016, the Applicant, a D-2 Director of Mission Support serving with the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUSCO) filed an Application on the merits before the Dispute Tribunal challenging the decision not to select him for the post of Director of Mission Support in the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali (MINUSMA).
2. The Respondent filed his Reply to the Application on 14 September 2016.
3. On 16 November 2016, the Applicant filed a Motion in which he informed the Tribunal that the parties had been engaged in discussions and that they had reached an amicable settlement of the case. The Applicant also moved the Tribunal to withdraw his Application.

ORDER

4. The Tribunal hereby GRANTS the Applicant's Motion and ORDERS that the matter of *Siri v Secretary-General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2016/059) be struck off the Court's docket.
