Introduction

1. On 21 December 2015, the Applicant filed an application challenging the decision to terminate her employment as a Research Assistant with the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA) in Beirut.
2. On 22 February 2016, the Respondent filed his reply to the application.
3. By Order No. 004 (NBI/2017) dated 3 January 2017, the Tribunal ordered the Respondent to provide further information in relation to the application. The Respondent submitted the requested information on 18 January 2017.
4. A case management discussion took place on 26 January 2017 in which the main issues of the case were discussed.
5. On 22 March 2017, the Respondent filed a motion for production of documents requesting the Tribunal to order the Applicant to produce documentary evidence showing: “[1] that she rejected job offers in order to take up employment at ESCWA; (2) all efforts she made to obtain employment to mitigate economic losses; and (3) all earnings during the period of her contract with ESCWA”.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY ORDERED THAT:

6. The Respondent’s motion is granted. The Applicant shall produce documentary evidence as mentioned in paragraph 5 above by no later than **Friday, 24 March 2017 at 5pm (Nairobi time)**.
