The Application and Procedural History

1. On 7 March 2016, the Applicant, a former staff member with the United Nations Mission in Liberia (UNMIL), filed an application challenging the Respondent's decision to abolish a post that he previously encumbered as a Finance Assistant (post number 50342), and the decision not to renew his fixed term appointment beyond 30 September 2015.

2. The Respondent filed his reply to the application on 8 April 2016.

3. On 23 February 2017, the Applicant moved to withdraw his application on grounds that he has considered the Respondent's arguments and concedes that he has no case.

ORDER

4. The Tribunal hereby **ORDERS** that the matter of *Clarkson v Secretary General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2016/018) be dismissed and struck off the Court's docket.
