Introduction

1. The Applicant is a Logistics Operations Officer at the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Mission in the Central African Republic (MINUSCA). He serves at the P4 level, on a permanent appointment, and is based in Bangui.

Procedural History

2. On 16 August 2017, the Applicant filed this Application challenging the decision to issue a Recruit from Roster vacancy announcement and ignore the obligation to give full and fair consideration to applicants for a previous position-specific job opening for the same position. He sought to injunct the Secretary-General from proceeding with the recruit-from-roster selection process.

3. The Respondent filed his Reply to the Application on 17 August 2017.

4. On 18 August 2017, the Applicant wrote to the Registry communicating his decision to withdraw his Application.

Order

5. The motion to withdraw is granted.

6. The Tribunal accordingly **ORDERS** that the matter of *Alam v Secretary General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2017/071) be struck-off the Tribunal's docket.
