# **ORDER ON THE APPLICANT'S NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL**

## Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former staff member of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).

2. On 2 February 2016, he filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal challenging the decision not to extend his assignment in the UNDP Kenya Country Office as a Deputy Resident Representative.

3. The Respondent filed his reply on 9 March 2016.

4. On 12 January 2017, the Respondent filed a motion for summary judgment on the ground that the relief requested by the Applicant had been provided.

5. The Applicant filed a response to the Respondent's motion on 27 January 2017.

6. On 30 August 2017, the Tribunal, through Order No. 142 (NBI/2017), directed the parties to attend a case management discussion on 7 September 2017.

7. On 6 September 2017, the Applicant moved the Tribunal to withdraw his application "due to changes in his circumstances".

# ORDER

8. The Tribunal hereby **ORDERS** that the matter of *Abaga v. Secretary-General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2016/011) be dismissed and struck off the Court's docket.
