Introduction

1. A Case Management Discussion ("CMD") took place on Monday, 27 November 2017. The parties were given the opportunity to engage in discussions pursuant to an alternative dispute resolution ("ADR") failing which a hearing would take place during the week of 22 January 2018 to consider all issues relating to liability and, if appropriate, remedy.

2. The Tribunal stayed further proceedings for a period of 30 days until 27 December 2017.

3. On 14 December 2017, the parties informed the Tribunal that they were unable to reach ADR.

4. On 26 and 27 December 2017, the parties filed their witness lists.

5. The Tribunal will provide the parties with the opportunity to submit their evidence and submissions on both liability and remedy so that the Tribunal will have before it all the material necessary to issue a final judgment in the case.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

6. The hearing will be held on 23, 24 and, if necessary, 25 January 2018 starting at 10 am each day in the UNDT Courtroom (CR12) in Nairobi.

7. The Applicant will give evidence first.

8. The Respondent will call Mr. Koen Davidse, MINUSMA Deputy Representative of the Secretary-General, Political Affairs, to provide a full explanation of the reasons for the decision why the Applicant was not offered the fixed-term Gender Affairs Officer (P-3) position.

9. The parties will cooperate to provide an agreed, and paginated bundle of relevant documents including a chronology of key events. The bundle should be filed with the Registry via CCMS no later than 17 January 2018.

10. Counsel must come prepared to make their closing/final submissions at the end of witness testimony.
