## **Introduction**

1. On 13 March 2018, the Applicant, a staff member of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic (MINUSCA), filed an application challenging the decision “not to place [him] at the correct step, not to pay [him] the correct salary, and not to pay [him] dependency allowances and entitlements on account of his children and spouse”.

2. Upon the parties’ request, by Order No. 066 (NBI/2018) dated 19 April 2018, the proceedings were suspended until 21 May 2018 pending informal discussions with a view to an alternative resolution of the dispute. By Order No. 092 (NBI/2018) dated 25 May 2018, the suspension of the proceedings was further extended, upon the parties’ request, until 5 July 2018.

3. On 28 June 2018, Counsel acting on behalf of the Applicant filed a Motion and informed the Tribunal that, pursuant to the terms of a confidential settlement, the parties had reached an agreement to fully and finally settle the case and that accordingly, the Applicant wished to withdraw his application.

## **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

4. The Applicant’s Motion for withdrawal is hereby granted and it is accordingly **ORDERED** that the matter of *Handy v. Secretary-General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2018/036) be struck off the Court’s docket.
