## **Introduction**

1. At the time of the application, the Applicant was employed at the United Nations Mechanism for International Criminal Tribunals (MICT) on a fixed term appointment and was based in Arusha.

## **Procedural History**

2. On 19 July 2017, the Applicant filed an application challenging the decision(s) made in respect of the complaint she filed pursuant to ST/SGB/2008/5 in reference to the Prohibition of Discrimination, Harassment including Sexual Harassment and Abuse of Authority. She complains that the process was irregular and also requests a copy of the panel's report.

3. The Respondent filed his reply to the application on 17 August 2017.

4. On 12 October 2017, the Applicant filed a motion to amend her pleadings including her additional and amended pleadings with the motion.

5. The Respondent filed additional documents on 26 October 2017.

6. On 12 April 2018, the Applicant filed a motion for an expedited hearing of this matter.

## **Order**

7. For the expeditious disposition of this case, the Tribunal deems it necessary to call the parties to a case management discussion.

8. The parties should be prepared to address the Tribunal on i) any pending/interlocutory motions, and ii) their preparedness for an oral hearing of this matter.

9. A case management discussion in this case will take place on **12 September 2018 at 1500 hours** Nairobi time (GMT+3) in the UNDT boardroom.

10. Parties appearing remotely are required to provide the Registry with their contact details no later than **7 September 2018**.
