## **Introduction**

1. The Applicant is a Programme Coordinator with UN-Habitat. She serves at the P3 level on a fixed term appointment, and is based in Bukavu, Democratic Republic of the Congo.

## **The Application**

2. On 27 September 2018, the Applicant filed an application for suspension of action pending management evaluation in respect of the decision not to renew her appointment beyond 6 October 2018.

3. On 2 October 2018, the Respondent replied to the application indicating that the Applicant's appointment has been renewed to 31 December 2018, and that the Applicant would be informed of this decision on or before 6 October 2018.

4. On 3 October 2018, the Tribunal sought the Applicant's response to the Respondent's submissions.

5. On 4 October 2018, the Applicant moved for the case to be closed on the "basis of the assurances and submissions" made by the Respondent.

## **ORDERS**

6. The Tribunal hereby **GRANTS** the Applicant's Motion and **ORDERS** that the matter of *Torres Sibille v Secretary General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2018/100) be struck from this Court's docket.
