## **Introduction**

1. On 4 January 2018, the Applicant filed an application challenging the decision of the Director-General of the United Nations Office at Nairobi not to provide him with a summary of the findings and conclusions of an investigation initiated under ST/SGB/2008/5 (Prohibition of discrimination, harassment, including sexual harassment, and abuse of authority).
2. The Respondent's reply was filed on 8 February 2018.
3. On 18 October 2018, the Applicant moved the Tribunal to withdraw his application on the ground that he has now received the full investigation report that was prepared in relation to his ST/SGB/2008/5 complaint and therefore he considers that the present proceedings have been rendered moot.

## **ORDER**

4. The Applicant's Motion for withdrawal is hereby granted and it is accordingly **ORDERED** that the matter of *Kanhema v. The Secretary-General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2018/004) be struck off the Court's docket.
