Introduction

1. At the time of application, the Applicant was serving as Resettlement Assistant with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) sub-office in Kakuma, Kenya.
2. The Applicant was separated from service for misconduct on 9 March 2018.
3. On 7 May 2018, the Applicant filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Nairobi challenging the Respondent's decision to dismiss her from service.
4. The Respondent filed his reply to the application on 11 June 2018.

Order

5. For the purposes of the expeditious disposition of this case, and efficient use of the Tribunal's resources, the Tribunal deems it necessary to call the parties to a case management discussion.
6. The Tribunal also takes the view that the services of counsel will assist the Applicant and the Tribunal in the management and conduct of this case.

8. The Tribunal therefore **directs service** of the present Order on (OSLA) to facilitate the process.
9. For the case management discussion, Parties should be prepared to address the Tribunal on their preparedness for an oral hearing to be held in this matter, and any issues relevant to the hearing being held.

10. A case management discussion in this case will take place on **9 December 2019** at 1100 hours Nairobi time (GMT+3) in the UNDT boardroom.

11. Parties appearing remotely are required to provide the Registry with their contact details no later than **6 December 2019**.
