## **Introduction**

1. At the time of application, the Applicant was serving as a nurse at the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUSCO). She held a fixed-term appointment at the G4 level, and was stationed in Bukavu.
2. The Applicant was separated from service for misconduct on 1 March 2018.
3. On 7 May 2018, the Applicant filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Nairobi challenging the Respondent's decision to dismiss her from service.
4. The Respondent filed his reply to the Application on 8 June 2018.

## **Order**

5. For the purposes of the expeditious disposition of this case, and efficient use of the Tribunal's resources, the Tribunal deems it necessary to call the parties to a case management discussion.
6. For the case management discussion, Parties should be prepared to address the Tribunal on their preparedness for an oral hearing to be held in this matter, and any issues relevant to the hearing being held.
7. A case management discussion in this case will take place on **10 December 2019** at 1600 hours Nairobi time (GMT+3) in the UNDT boardroom.
8. Parties appearing remotely are required to provide the Registry with their contact details no later than **6 December 2019**.
