Introduction

1. The Applicant filed an application on 27 February 2018 contesting the decision not to include him in the roster of qualified candidates for future job openings for the position of Chief of Unit, Air Operations, at the P-4 level.
2. The Tribunal deems it necessary to receive further submissions from the parties to decide on how to fairly and expeditiously dispose of this matter.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

3. The parties are to consult with each other regarding the possibility of informally settling this matter.
4. Should informal settlement not be possible, the parties shall file a joint submission by 23 March 2020 that:
 - a. Identifies with as much precision as possible, the essence of the claim and the core issues requiring factual determination by the Tribunal;
 - b. Identifies relevant jurisprudence and administrative issuances the Tribunal should take into consideration.
 - c. Stipulates any motions that the parties may have.
 - d. Specifies whether the case may be decided on the documents or whether an oral hearing is necessary.
 - e. Should the parties deem a hearing to be necessary, they should:
 - i. identify the witnesses to be called and provide a synopsis of their oral evidence;
 - ii. agree on dates during the week of 20 April 2020 for a hearing; and
 - iii. compile a paginated hearing bundle.
