# **ORDER**

### Background

1. In a revised application dated 24 September 2019, the Applicant, a staff member of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), is contesting UNFPA's decision not to consider the periods from 29 November 2016 to 12 February 2017 and 10 March to 29 April 2017 as sick leave.

2. The parties filed a joint motion on 22 October 2019 moving the Tribunal to suspend proceedings for 60 days to enable them to engage in informal resolution of the dispute and to extend the deadline for the Respondent's reply to 28 December 2019.

3. The attempt at informal resolution was unsuccessful and the reply was filed on 26 December 2019.

#### ORDERS

4. The Applicant shall file her response to the reply by or before 3 February 2020.

5. In said response, the Applicant shall indicate which of her claims have been satisfied, those that remain outstanding and which reliefs she now seeks.
