# **ORDER ON EXTENSION OF TIME TO** FILE THE APPLICANT'S RESPONSE **TO ORDER NO. 018 (NBI/2020)**

#### Introduction

1. On 4 February 2020, the Applicant, a Language Assistant at the GS-4 level working with the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL), filed, through counsel, a motion for three-week extension of time to respond to Order No. 018 (NBI/2020), which had required her to articulate contested facts and evidence in support thereof.

2. The Applicant did not state any reasons for her request for the extension of time.

## Considerations

3. Having considered its current workload the Tribunal holds that, exceptionally, the interests of justice will not suffer from granting the requested extension of time. The Tribunal, however puts the Applicant on notice that no further motions for extension of time will be entertained. Absent a submission on time, the Tribunal will proceed to finalize the case based on the dossier before it.
