ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. On 28 November 2019, the Applicant filed an application requesting for the execution of Judgment No. UNDT/2015/004.

2. On 18 February 2020, the Respondent filed a reply, where it is argued that the Judgment has been fully executed. The Secretary-General elected to pay the Applicant the awarded compensation in lieu of reinstatement.

3. In light of the submissions by the Respondent, the Tribunal notes that the Respondent does not detail how the compensation was effected. In particular, the SWIFT document offered by way of proof (R/2) is not legible and is incapable of showing whether the Respondent complied with the Tribunal's Judgment on compensation and related dispositions.

ORDERS

4. The Tribunal directs the Respondent to demonstrate through clear documentation, supported by a narrative, how he complied with the Tribunal's Judgment and to show comprehensively how each of the dispositions contained in paragraphs 132, 133 and 134 of the Judgment were implemented.

5. The deadline for the submission of the requested information shall be on Monday, 9 March 2020.
