# ORDER

## SETTING THE DEADLINE FOR FINAL SUBMISSIONS

## Background

1. On 19 February 2018, the Applicant filed an application challenging his nonselection for a United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) P-3 Resettlement Officer position in Brasilia, Brazil.

2. On 16 December 2019, the Tribunal issued Order No. 219 (NBI/2019) paragraph six of which states:

Should the Tribunal find that the application is receivable, the parties shall immediately, as from the date of the order on receivability, comply with the directions in paragraphs 3 (c) to (g) agreeing amongst themselves on time limits within which to file and exchange submissions including final submissions bearing in mind that the judge seized of this case's deployment expires on 31 March and that she is desirous of disposing of this case before then.

3. On 13 January 2020, the Tribunal issued Judgment No. UNDT/2020/004 in which it found that this application is receivable.

4. On 26 February 2020, the Applicant filed a motion requesting the tribunal o direct the Respondent to provide further information and disclose documents. On the same day, the Tribunal issued Order No. 048 (NBI/2020) directing the Respondent to file a response to the issues raised in the Applicant's motion. The Respondent filed submissions in response to Order No. 048 on 11 March 2020.

## ORDER

5. The parties shall file their final submissions by 20 March 2020.
