Introduction and Procedural History

1. The Applicant served as a Geospatial Information Officer at the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilisation Mission in Mali ("MINUSMA"). He held a fixed term appointment at the FS-5 level.

- 2. On 12 November 2018, the Applicant challenged the Respondent's decision to separate him from service with compensation *in lieu* of notice and termination indemnity in accordance with staff rule 10.2(a)(viii).
- 3. The Respondent filed his reply to the application on 14 December 2018.
- 4. On 17 April 2020, the Tribunal issued Order No. 073 (NBI/2020) setting this matter down for a case management discussion ("CMD").
- 5. On 8 May 2020, the CMD took place in the presence of counsel for both parties and the Applicant. The Tribunal issued Order No. 090 (NBI/2020) recording the contents that discussion.
- 6. The parties have advised the Tribunal that an *inter partes* settlement is not possible in this matter.
- 7. The Respondent filed his submissions pursuant to Order No. 090 (NBI/2020) on 22 May 2020.

Orders

- 8. The Tribunal has considered the parties' submissions and takes the view that allowing an oral hearing would facilitate the fair conduct of proceedings in this matter.
- 9. The Tribunal hereby **ORDERS** the **joint submission of a clearly paginated trial bundle** and **cross disclosure of the parties' witness lists**, with a summary of
