Introduction and Procedural History

1. The Applicant served as a Security Officer at the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilisation Mission in Mali (“MINUSMA”). He held a fixed term appointment at the FS-4 level and was based in Bamako.
2. On 21 December 2018, the Applicant challenged the Respondent’s decision to separate him from service with compensation *in lieu* of notice without termination indemnity in accordance with staff rule 10.2(a)(viii).
3. The Respondent filed his reply to the application on 25 January 2019.
4. The Tribunal held a case management discussion (CMD) on 4 May 2020, and issued Order No. 086 (NBI/2020) recording the contents of the discussion.
5. The Applicant filed a rejoinder to his application on 11 May 2020.
6. On 15 May 2020, the parties jointly informed the Tribunal that this matter cannot be resolved *inter partes*.

Orders

7. Having reviewed the parties submissions to-date, the Tribunal makes the following Orders:
 - a. The Respondent will file his closing submissions by **Friday, 5 June 2020**;
 - b. The Applicant will file his closing and final submissions by **Monday, 15 June 2020**.
8. The Tribunal will, thereafter, proceed to determine this matter on the basis of the written submissions before it.
