Background

1. At the time of filing his application, the Applicant was a Senior Political Affairs Officer, Office of the Joint Special Representative at the United Nations-African Union Mission in Darfur (“UNAMID”).
2. On 7 November 2018, he filed this application challenging the decision to remove him from his position as Senior Child Protection Advisor and to reassign him as a Senior Political Affairs Officer within UNAMID (“the contested decision”).
3. On 14 December 2018, the Respondent filed his reply to the application.

ORDER

4. By 5.00 p.m. on Monday, 15 June 2020, the Applicant shall file in CCMS brief submissions, not exceeding five pages and including any evidence (expert or otherwise), that he suffered any kind of harm as a result of the contested decision.
