## Introduction

1. The Applicant held a fixed term appointment as a Special Assistant, Political Affairs, at the P4/VI level with the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic (“MINUSCA”) in Bangui, Central African Republic. He is challenging the non-renewal of his appointment beyond 31 December 2017 following what he claims to be a flawed performance appraisal.

2. The parties were strongly encouraged by the Tribunal to settle the dispute *inter partes*.

3. On 9 July 2020, the Applicant informed the Tribunal that the matter has been settled and that he was therefore withdrawing the application.

## Considerations

4. The Tribunal commends the parties for their sustained efforts at having this matter resolved without recourse to further litigation.

5. The Tribunal hereby **RECORDS** the contents of the Applicant’s Notice of Withdrawal and **ORDERS** that the matter of *Rubvuta v Secretary General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2018/041) be struck off the Court’s docket.
