Introduction

1. The Applicant is a Budget and Finance Assistant at the GS-5 level, working with the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (“UNIFIL”) based in Naqoura.¹
2. By an application filed on 26 August 2019, the Applicant is contesting a decision not to select her for the position of Assistant Administrative Officer, National Professional Officer (“NPO”), in the Language Support Unit of UNIFIL.²
3. The Respondent filed a reply on 25 September 2019.³
4. On 24 September 2020, during the case management discussion, the parties agreed to have a hearing in the week of 19-23 October 2020.
5. On 2 October 2020, the Respondent submitted to the Tribunal a list comprising two witnesses, who will testify in the case.

ORDERS

6. The hearing in the matter of *Mokled v. The Secretary-General of the United Nations* shall be held from **19 October 2020**, commencing at **12.00 noon**. Nairobi time (GMT+3) via Microsoft Teams. The Registry will provide a link to access the meeting.
7. It is the responsibility of the parties to ensure the availability of the witnesses for the hearing.
8. **On or before 13 October 2020**, the parties shall file with the Registry an agreed hearing schedule and agreed and paginated bundle of the documents which they intend to rely upon at the hearing. The bundle shall contain an index of the documents

contained therein. In the event that either party intends to refer their witnesses to any document in the bundle, said document should be provided to the witness in advance.

9. In accordance with art. 16.4 of the UNDT Rules of Procedure, the parties or their duly designated representatives must attend the hearing.

10. The parties and their witnesses are reminded that recording of courtroom proceedings is not permitted.
