Introduction

1. On 21 September 2020, the Applicant, a P-4 Conduct and Discipline Officer with the United Nations Interim Security Force for Abyei (“UNISFA”), filed an application before the United Nations Dispute Tribunal contesting the decision not to pay him Daily Subsistence Allowance (“DSA”).
2. On 7 October 2020, the parties informed the Tribunal that they are making good faith efforts to informally resolve the matter.
3. The parties moved for proceedings to be suspended for 30 days to enable them to conclude the settlement discussions; and for an extension of the statutory deadline for the filing of the Respondent’s reply. This motion was granted in Order No. 208 (NBI/2020).
4. On 12 November 2020, the Applicant informed the Tribunal that the dispute has been resolved *inter partes* and sought leave to withdraw proceedings.

Considerations

5. The Tribunal commends the parties for their sustained efforts resulting in the resolution of this dispute without recourse to further litigation.
6. The Applicant’s motion is **GRANTED** and the matter of *Fultang v Secretary General of the United Nations* (UNDT/NBI/2020/076) is hereby struck off the docket of the United Nations Dispute Tribunal.
