## **Introduction**

1. On 3 June 2019, the Applicant filed an application contesting a disciplinary sanction of summary dismissal imposed on her.
2. On 9 July 2019, the Respondent filed a reply to the application.

## **ORDERS**

3. The hearing in the matter of *Diallo v. The Secretary-General of the United Nations* shall be held from **24-25 March 2021**, commencing each day at **14.30 p.m.** Nairobi time (GMT+3) via Microsoft Teams. The Registry will provide a link to access the meeting.
4. It is the responsibility of the parties to ensure the availability of their witnesses at the hearing.
5. **On or before 17 March 2021**, the parties shall file with the Registry an agreed and paginated bundle of the documents which they intend to rely upon at the hearing. The bundle shall contain an index of the documents contained therein. In the event that either party intends to refer their witnesses to any document in the bundle, said document should be provided to the witness in advance.
6. In accordance with art. 16.4 of the UNDT Rules of Procedure, the parties or their duly designated representatives must attend the hearing.
7. The parties and their witnesses are reminded that recording of courtroom proceedings is not permitted.
