Introduction

1. By applications filed on 24 July 2018, the Applicants challenge the decision of the Secretary-General to apply the new post adjustment multiplier for Geneva on their salaries, as of February 2018, as decided by the International Civil Service Commission ("ICSC") in July 2017.¹

2. The Respondent filed a reply to the applications on 24 September 2018 in which it is argued that their claim is not receivable and, if found receivable, the contested decision was lawful.²

3. On 19 March 2021, the United Nations Appeals Tribunal issued Judgment No. 2021-UNAT-1107 in *Abd Al-Shakour et al* and *Aksioutine et al* cases which were based on the same set of facts and involved the same legal issues.

ORDERS

4. In consideration of the above UNAT Judgment, by 5.00 p.m. on Thursday, 27 May 2021, the parties may, if they so wish:

- a. amend their pleadings;
- b. show that their cases are distinguishable from *Abd Al-Shakour et al* and *Aksioutine et al*.

5. Absent a response, the Tribunal will proceed to judgment based on the pleadings such as put presently before it.
