Introduction

1. On 17 October 2019, the Applicant, a former Programme Analyst, at the G-7 level, working with the United Nations Development Programme in Djibouti, filed an application before the Dispute Tribunal.¹ He contests the disciplinary measure of separation from service with compensation in lieu of notice and with two months' salary as termination indemnity.²
2. The Respondent filed a reply on 7 November 2019.

ORDERS

3. The hearing in the matter of *Salem v. The Secretary-General of the United Nations* shall be held on **30-31 August 2021 and on 3 September 2021**, commencing at **3.30 p.m.** and ending at **5.30 p.m.** each day- Nairobi time (GMT+3) via Microsoft Teams. The Registry will provide a link to access the meeting.
4. It is the responsibility of the Respondent to ensure the availability of the witnesses at the hearing.
5. Should either party intend to refer the witnesses to any document, the said document should be provided to the Registry and the witness in advance.
6. In accordance with art. 16.4 of the UNDT Rules of Procedure, the parties or their duly designated representatives must attend the hearing.
7. The parties and their witnesses are reminded that recording of courtroom proceedings is not permitted.
