Introduction

1. The Applicant is a P-4 Joint Operations Officer with the United Nations

Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic

("MINUSCA").

Procedural History

2. The Applicant has two applications pending before the United Nations Dispute

Tribunal sitting in Nairobi.

3. On 16 December 2020, she challenged the Respondent's decision to strip her off

her existing functions and reassign her.

4. On 2 February 2021, she challenged the decision "not to implement the MEU

determination to rollback and complete her 2017-2018 ePAS, as well as the

Administration's failure to complete and furnish her in a timely fashion with her ePAS

for 2018-2019 and 2019-2020."

5. Both matters are currently the subject of *inter partes* settlement discussions, and

the parties have jointly moved the Tribunal for proceedings in both cases to be further

suspended.

6. The parties inform the Tribunal that subsequent to the issuance of Order No. 101

(NBI/2021), settlement discussions have been productive and that they are currently

finalising the terms of the settlement agreement. To this end, the parties moved the

Tribunal to extend the suspension of proceedings by another two weeks.

7. The Respondent additionally seeks postponement of the deadline for the filing of

his replies until 9 July 2021.
