Introduction

1. On 22 July 2021, the Applicant filed an application contesting the decision by the United Nations – African Union Hybrid Operation in Darfur (“UNAMID”) to terminate her continuing appointment without making reasonable and good faith efforts to assist her to find a suitable alternative position.

2. By Order Nos. 162 (NBI/2021) and 233 (NBI/2021), the Tribunal suspended proceedings and extended the deadline for filing of the Respondent’s reply until 22 December 2021 to allow the parties to engage in informal settlement discussions with a view to resolving the matter without litigation.

3. On 20 December 2021, the parties filed a joint motion seeking a further suspension of proceedings and extension of the deadline for the Respondent’s reply until 21 January 2022 to finalize their agreement.

Order

4. The parties’ joint motion is granted.

5. The proceedings are suspended and the deadline for the Respondent’s reply is extended until 21 January 2022.
