ORDER ON THE APPLICANT'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION

Introduction

1. On 22 July 2021, the Applicant filed an application contesting the decision by the United Nations – African Union Hybrid Operation in Darfur ("UNAMID") to terminate her continuing appointment without making reasonable and good faith efforts to assist her to find a suitable alternative position.

2. By Order Nos. 162 (NBI/2021), 233 (NBI/2021) and 262 (NBI/2021), the Tribunal suspended proceedings and extended the deadline for filing of the Respondent's reply until 21 January 2022 to allow the parties to engage in informal settlement discussions with a view to resolving the matter without litigation.

3. On 15 January 2022, the Applicant informed the Tribunal that the matter has been resolved informally and that she wishes to withdraw her application.

Order

4. The Tribunal commends the parties for making best efforts to resolve this matter informally.

5. Following the notice of withdrawal, Case No. UNDT/NBI/2021/059 is hereby closed and removed from the docket.
