Introduction

1. On 30 June 2021, the Applicant, a Supply Officer, at P-3 level, working with

the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central

African Republic ("MINUSCA") in Bangui, Central African Republic, filed an

application contesting what she terms as a continued improper stripping of her

managerial and other substantive duties.<sup>1</sup>

2. On 2 August 2021, the Respondent filed a reply where it was argued that the

contested decision is legal and rational and that the Secretary-General properly

exercised his discretion to organize the work of the General Supply Unit in the interest

of the Organization.

3. The Tribunal held a case management discussion ("CMD") on 13 April 2022.

During the discussion, the parties declared readiness to informally settle the case.

**Deliberation** 

4. Pursuant to art. 19 of the United Nations Dispute Tribunal ("UNDT") Rules of

Procedure, the UNDT may at any time, either on an application of a party or on its own

initiative, issue any order or give any direction which appears to a judge to be

appropriate for the fair and expeditious disposal of the case and to do justice to the

parties.

**ORDER** 

5. On or before 25 April 2022, the parties shall inform the Tribunal as to whether

the case has been resolved. If so, the Applicant shall confirm to the Tribunal, in writing,

that her application is withdrawn finally and entirely.
