## **Introduction**

1. On 16 December 2021, the Applicant filed an application before the Dispute Tribunal. He contests the disciplinary measure imposed on him of separation from service with compensation in lieu of notice and with half the termination indemnity.
2. The Respondent filed a reply on 19 January 2022 and argues that the application is without merit.
3. In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management discussion (“CMD”). The purpose of the CMD is to:
  - a. discuss and identify the claims and issues in the case;
  - b. discuss any possibility for an amicable resolution of the case;
  - c. order, as appropriate, the arrangements for a hearing on the merits of the case, including the identification of relevant witnesses; and
  - d. generally deal with any other matter relating to the consideration and determination of this application.
