ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former Close Protection Officer working with the United Nations Mission in the Republic of South Sudan. He filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Nairobi on 31 December 2021 to contest the decision to impose on him a disciplinary measure of separation from service with compensation in lieu of notice and without termination indemnity; together with a fine of one month's salary; recovery action; and inclusion of his name on the ClearCheck database.¹

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 3 February 2022 and requests the Tribunal to reject the application.

3. In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management discussion ("CMD"). The purpose of the CMD is to:

a. discuss and identify the claims and issues in the case;

b. discuss any possibility for an amicable resolution of the case;

c. order, as appropriate, the arrangements for a hearing on the merits of the case, including the identification of relevant witnesses; and

d. generally deal with any other matter relating to the consideration and determination of this application.

ORDERS

4. A CMD in this case will take place on **14 July 2022 at 2 p.m.** (Nairobi Time, UTC +3) via Microsoft Teams.
