## **Introduction**

1. By Order No. 073 (NBI/2022) issued on 30 June 2022, the Tribunal scheduled a case management discussion (“CMD”) that was to be held on 7 July 2022. The purpose of the CMD was to:

- a. discuss and identify the claims and issues in the case;
- b. discuss any possibility for an amicable resolution of the case;
- c. order, as appropriate, the arrangements for a hearing on the merits of the case, including the identification of relevant witnesses; and
- d. generally deal with any other matter relating to the consideration and determination of the application.

2. On the day of the scheduled CMD, neither the Applicant nor her Counsel turned up for the CMD. There was no response to Order No. 073 (NBI/2022). The Applicant’s Counsel did not also respond to the emails and phone calls from the Registry.

## **ORDERS**

3. The Applicant is directed to file submissions addressing:

- a. Matters that were to be discussed at the CMD;
- b. If she needs an oral hearing, the Applicant should file a list of witnesses and a summary of what each witness will testify about.

4. The required submissions shall be filed no later than **19 July 2022** and should not exceed five pages.

5. Should the Applicant fail to file the required submissions as directed, the Tribunal will proceed to determine the application based on the documents before it.
