Introduction

1. At the time of the application, the Applicant served as Conduct and Discipline Officer at the United Nations Interim Security Force for Abyei (“UNISFA”). He serves on a continuing appointment at the P-4 level.
2. On 14 April 2022, the Applicant filed an application to challenge the Respondent’s decision of 10 January 2022 to extend his Administrative Leave With Pay (“ALWP”) for a further three months, or until the completion of an investigation into his conduct and any disciplinary process.
3. The Respondent filed his reply on 21 May 2022 stating the impugned decision was lawful and rational.

Order

4. The Tribunal has reviewed the parties’ submissions and, having in mind articles 16.1 and 2 of the Rules of Procedure of the UNDT, takes the view that the relevant facts in the present case are clear and there is no need to conduct a hearing on the merits as the matter can be determined on the basis of the documents on record.
5. To this end, the parties are **DIRECTED** to file by **16 August 2022** their closing submissions, which can have the maximum length of 10 pages, using Times New Roman, font size 12, line spacing 1.5.
