ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former Assistant Protection Officer working with the United Nations High Commission for Refugees "UNHCR" in the Republic of Uganda. She filed an application with the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Nairobi on 28 January 2022, to contest the High Commissioner's decision to impose on her the disciplinary measure of dismissal in accordance with staff rule 10.2 (a) (ix).

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 2 March 2022 and requests the Tribunal to dismiss the application in its entirety for lack of merit.

3. In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management discussion ("CMD"). The purpose of the CMD is to:

a. Discuss and identify the claims and issues in the case,

b. Discuss any possibility for an amicable resolution of the case,

c. Order, as appropriate, the arrangements for a hearing on the merits of the case, including the identification of relevant witnesses; documentary evidence and

d. Generally, deal with any other matter relating to the consideration and determination of this application.

ORDERS

4. A CMD in this case will take place virtually on 26 September 2022, commencing at 3 p.m. (Nairobi Time, UTC +3) via Microsoft Teams.

5. The parties or their duly designated representatives must attend the CMD. The Registry will provide a link to access the meeting.
