ORDER ON THE APPLICANT'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW THE APPLICATION

Introduction

- 1. The Applicant is contesting the decision to reassign him by way of lateral transfer to a Regular Programme of Technical Cooperation post on a three-month contract, renewable up to six months, in preparation for on boarding a new member of staff to the Applicant's current position.
- 2. On 12 October 2022, the Tribunal issued Order No. 149 (NBI/2022) in which, *inter alia*, the deadline for the Respondent to file closing submissions was set at 14 November 2022.
- 3. On 15 November 2022, the parties filed a joint motion requesting the Tribunal to stay and/or suspend the proceedings for 30 days as they were negotiating for a potential settlement. On the same date, the Tribunal suspended the proceedings until 5.00 p.m. (Nairobi time) on 13 December 2022.
- 4. On 23 November 2022, the Respondent wrote to the Tribunal to advise that parties had reached agreement and that the necessary paperwork was being prepared.
- 5. On 14 December 2022, the Applicant filed a motion seeking leave to withdraw the application on the ground that, on 14 December 2022, the parties executed a settlement agreement in full and final settlement of this case.

ORDERS

- 6. The Tribunal commends the parties for having resolved this matter *inter* partes.
- 7. The Tribunal hereby ORDERS that Case No. UNDT/NBI/2022/013 be struck off its docket.
