# **ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT**

## Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former staff member of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia ("ESCWA").<sup>1</sup> He commenced his retirement effective 1 September 2022.<sup>2</sup>

2. The Tribunal held a case management discussion ("CMD") on 27 April 2023. During the CMD, the Applicant was, among others, requested to file supporting documents for harm he may have suffered and indicate if he wishes to call witnesses.

3. On 8 May 2023, the Applicant complied and filed the submissions.

4. In view of the latest submissions by the Applicant, it is ORDERED as follows:
