ORDER ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. By an application filed on 15 March 2023, the Applicant contests his dismissal from service in accordance with staff rule 10.2(a)(ix).

2. On 17 May 2023, the Respondent filed a reply where it was argued that the application is without merit and that it should be rejected.

3. On 3 July 2023, the Applicant filed a motion for temporary relief. He submits that, following his separation from service, the Organization has not paid him any emoluments. He further states that the Administration has not released his Separation Notification Form (PF/4) to the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, hence delaying the processing of his pension. Failure to pay him and to release his separation form have left him financially crippled.

4. In view of the Applicant's submissions in the said motion, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management discussion ("CMD"). The purpose of the CMD is to:

- a. discuss and identify the claims and issues in the motion;
- b. discuss any possibility for an amicable resolution of the issue;
- c. generally deal with any other matter(s) relating to the consideration and determination of this motion; and
- d. discuss the arrangements for a hearing on the merits of the case, including the identification of relevant witnesses and supplemental documentary evidence, if any.

ORDERS

A CMD in this case will take place on 12 July at 10 a.m. (Nairobi Time, UTC +3). The CMD shall be held in person in the UNDT courtroom.

6. The parties or their duly designated representatives must attend the CMD.
