## **Introduction**

1. The Applicant filed an application on 23 March 2023 contesting the decision to impose on him the disciplinary measure of dismissal, in accordance with staff rule 10.2(a)(ix).
2. The Respondent filed a reply on 27 April 2023 requesting the Tribunal to reject the application.
3. The Tribunal held a case management discussion (“CMD”) on 24 October 2023. At the CMD, the following matters were discussed:
  - a. Preparation of a joint statement of agreed and disputed facts by the parties;
  - b. The number of witnesses to be called by each party;
  - c. If any of the witnesses will need interpretation services; and
  - d. Scheduling the oral hearing of the case.

## **ORDERS**

4. On or before **27 November 2023**, the parties shall file a joint statement setting forth:
  - a. All of the agreed facts;
  - b. A list of the disagreed facts. For each disagreed fact, each party shall indicate the evidence (named witness and/or document) they intend to offer to prove or disprove that fact;
  - c. Any objections to the evidence proffered by the other side, and the response to those objections; and

d. For each named witness, the estimated length of their testimony, whether they will require interpretation services, and their availability for an oral hearing of the case, preferably in the second or third week of January 2024.
