Introduction

1. The Applicant, a former Conduct and Discipline Officer at the United Nations Interim Security Force in Abyei, filed an application on 22 January 2023 to contest the decisions to:

- a. Impose on him the disciplinary measure of dismissal in accordance with staff rule 10.2(a)(ix);
- b. Require him to reimburse the Organization for its financial loss up to the amount of USD17,213.00 in accordance with staff rules 10.1(b) and 10.2(b)(ii); and
- c. Recover said amount (USD17,213.00), to the extent possible, from his final entitlements or emoluments, in accordance with staff rule 3.18(c)(ii).

2. The Respondent filed a reply on 22 February 2023 in which he requests the Tribunal to reject the application.

3. The Tribunal held a case management discussion (“CMD”) on 18 January 2024. At the CMD, the following matters were discussed:

- a. Filing of a joint statement on disputed and undisputed facts;
- b. Identification of witnesses and relevant documents to be used in the hearing on the merits; and
- c. Time and duration of the hearing.

Orders

4. On or before **Tuesday, 20 February 2024**, the parties shall file a joint statement on disputed and undisputed facts. For every disputed fact, each party shall indicate the evidence (document and/or named witness) they intend to offer to prove or disprove that fact.
